PRESENTATION OF PAPERS

A summary of four pages maximum, in 12 point Arial font, single spaced, 8½x11 format and margins of 2.5 cm on each side, using 7.0 Word text processor or higher should be sent by e-mail. The text will be composed of a title, a maximum of five authors with full name and surname, institution, postal and e-mail addresses, fax and a summary (250 words maximum), introduction, materials and methods,

main results and discussion, conclusions and bibliographic references (maximum of eight). Tables and figures should be included in the text. Papers should be submitted directly by e-mail to contacts for this meeting or to the Organizing Committee.
